

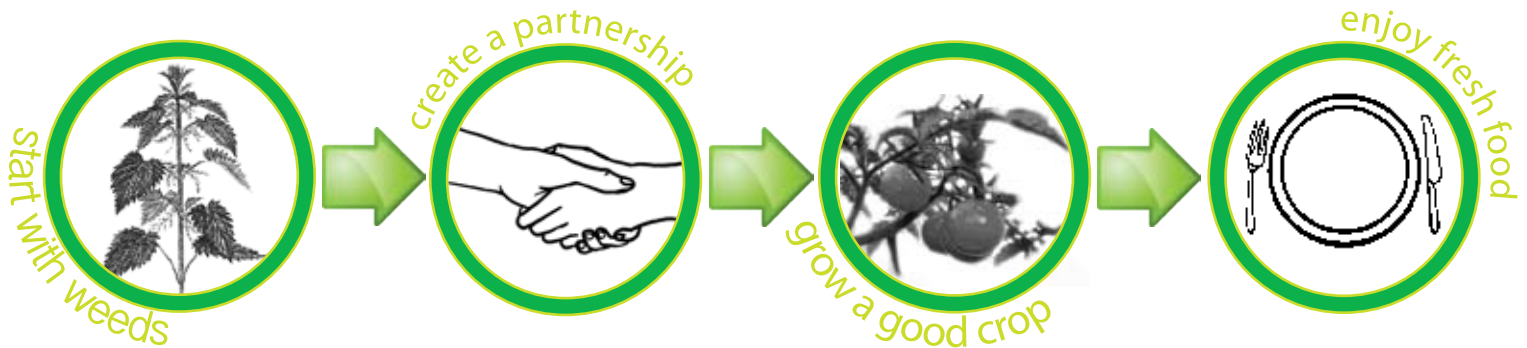
Do you struggle to maintain your garden?
